# Pathways for Public Dental Treatment for Children



### Children eligible for treatment at a Public Dental Clinic?

- \*Anyone under 13 years of age, irrespective of family income.
- \*Age 13-17 years of age with a Health Care card or Pension Card
- \*Age 2-17 years of age who are eligible for *Child Dental Benefits Scheme*
- \*Asylum seeker

\*Refugee

\*Indigenous

\*Intellectual Disability

Children age 13-17 who do not have a Health Care Card or Pension Card, or who do not qualify for Family Tax Benefit A, may not be eligible for dental treatment at a Public Dental Clinic.

## An eligible child wishes to seek dental treatment.

There is **no waiting list** for dental treatment for eligible children.

There is **no co-payment** or fee for treatment.
